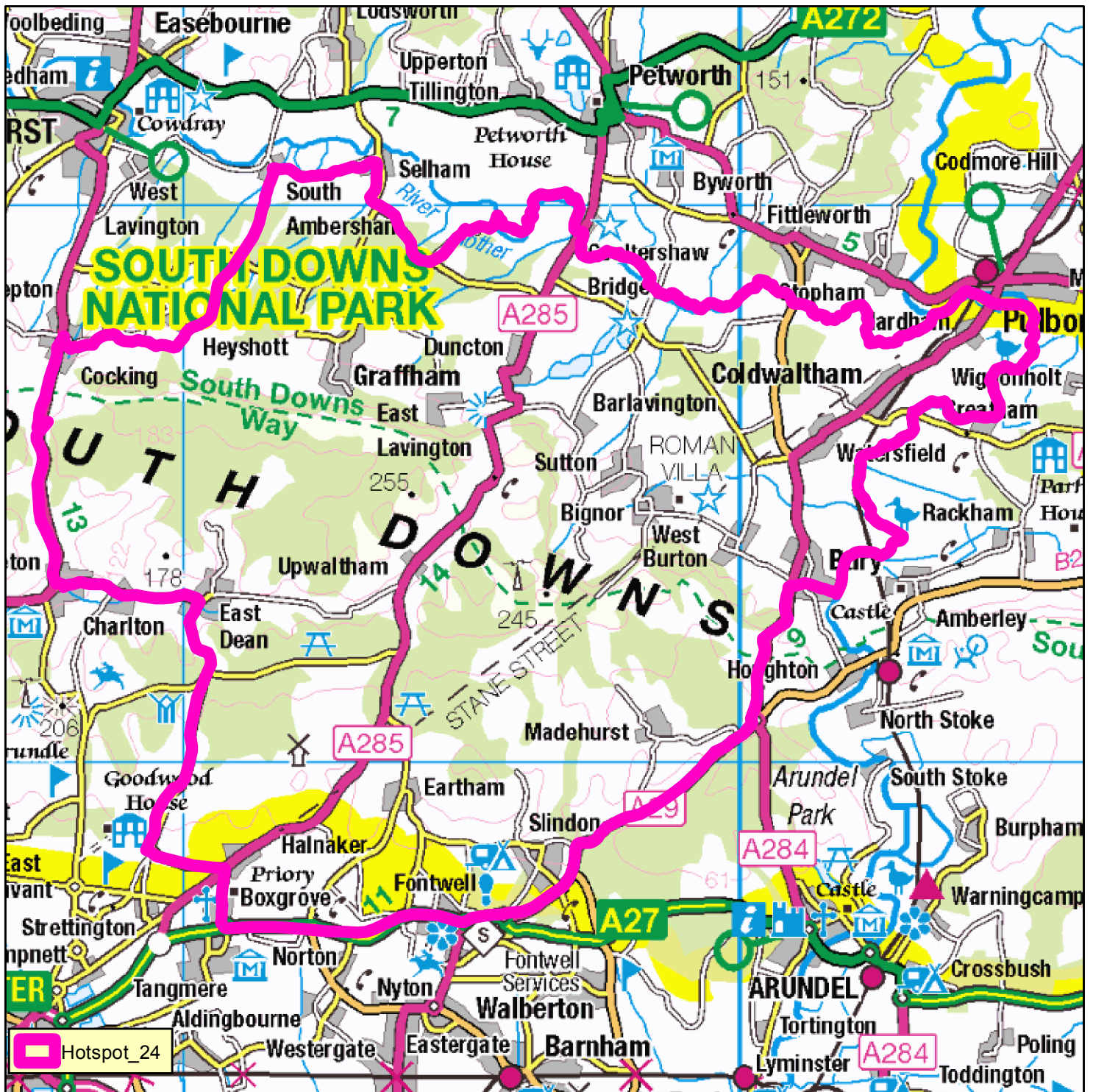


HOTSPOT 24

OFFICIAL SENSITIVE



Starting in the north of the potential hotspot area, the boundary runs from the village of Selham (to the east of Midhurst), south along an unclassified road towards Little Selham where the road veers south east over Barnett' Bridge until the cross-roads after Brookside Farm. Here the boundary follows the road north eastwards, following the track past Cathanger Farm and over the disused railway until it reaches the River Rother. It now follows the river until Lower Fittleworth. Here the boundary runs south for a quarter of a mile along the B2138 before veering west on an unclassified road to Coates, on into the woods, then turning southwards to West Burton, then along West Burton Road until reaching the B2138 again at Bury. It follows the B2138 southwards until the roundabout at Whiteways Lodge where it turns south west along the A29 until Fontwell where it then proceeds west along the A27 until Boxgrove. Here the boundary turns north along an unclassified road until veering west after the crossroads on the A285, following the unclassified road as it then runs north to the east of Goodwood Park until the village of East Dean. It then follows the road west to Charlton and Singleton and then runs north along the A286 to Cocking. From here it follows the unclassified road eastwards, running just south of Heyshott to Hoyle and then northward to South Ambersham where it deviates eastward along an unclassified road to Selham.
